# **Stonebridge Pool Regulations**

## Swim At Your Own Risk- No Lifeguard on Duty

### Membership:

- **Eligibility**: Only homeowners and their families living in Stonebridge POA who are in good standing can be members. Renters can become members if the homeowner is in good standing.
- **Guests**: Family members not living in SPOA property are considered guests. Members not in good standing cannot come as guests.
- **Delinquency**: Pool privileges are revoked if the homeowner's assessments are delinquent. Renters must show a rental agreement for membership.

#### Admission:

- **Pool Pass:** Passes will be managed in the MOKO software. Residents will create an account and profile in order to access the pool.
- Check-In: Members must check in and out with the attendant. Guest passes will be recorded digitally. Residents can keep track of guest passes on their MOKO account.
- **Supervision**: Minors residents 15-years-old and under must be accompanied by a parent, legal guardian, or responsible SPOA resident who is at least 18-years-old. Direct supervision means "line of sight."

### Consequences for Adults:

- Warnings: One warning before being required to leave for the day.
- **Noncompliance**: Habitual noncompliance may result in suspension or revocation of membership.

### Consequences for Children (15 and Under):

- 1st Offense: Verbal warning.
- 2nd Offense: Sit outside the pool for 15 minutes.
- 3rd Offense: Loss of pool privileges for the rest of the day.

### **General Pool Rules**

- 1. General Safety:
  - o Walk in the pool area; no running, rough play, or towel slapping.
  - o No diving, flips, cartwheels into the pool.
  - o Jumping from the red painted area is prohibited.
  - o No jumping over people.
  - o No raft, inflatables, or innertubes are permitted in the pool.
  - o Only floats for a small child are permitted. Arm floats and life vests are allowed. (Please see graphic)
  - o Sitting, hanging, and playing on the lane lines is prohibited.
  - o Water guns, squirt guns, or water shooters of any type are prohibited.

#### 2. **Behavior**:

- o No profanity, alcohol, illegal drugs, smoking, or vaping in the pool area.
- o Persons suspected of being under the influence will be asked to leave.

### 3. Health & Hygiene:

- o Infected or sick persons, and those with cuts or open wounds, are not allowed in the pool.
- o Swimsuits must be worn; no cutoffs or street clothes.
- o Children not yet potty-trained must wear a swim diaper at all times while in the pool.
- o No spitting, spouting water, or blowing the nose in the water.

#### 4. Food & Drink:

- o Only food and beverages in plastic containers are permitted.
- o No glassware, glass bottles, or gum.
- o Clean up all food and trash before leaving the pool area.

#### 5. **Courtesy**:

- o Be courteous to other members and guests.
- o Handicapped parking will be enforced.
- o A First Aid Kit is available on request from an adult.
- o Music permitted through earbuds and headphones only.
